Notes:

We ask that you pay a deposit of £100 at the time of booking and pay the remainder 3 months before the Wedding. Cheques should be made payable to 'Christ Church Ainsworth PCC'.

The Late Arrival Fee will be refunded providing both the bride and groom are stood in front of the minister ready to start the wedding no later than 10 minutes following the agreed start time. Otherwise the fee is forfeited. You should also be aware that, if your wedding starts late, we cannot guarantee that the choir or organist will stay. Should they be unable to stay, the choir and organist are entitled to retain their fees. **Should you be late, and the minister is unable to stay or if the Church is required for another service, your wedding will need to be rearranged.**

Flowers are not allowed in Church from Ash Wednesday until Easter Saturday (in 2020, 26th February until 11th April). There are normally flowers in Church at all other times.

The Statutory Fee payable to us is reduced by £31 if there is no requirement to call Banns.

The Organist's fee is increased by 50% if a video or audio recording is made of the service.

Fees for Marriage Certificates may increase at any time. Other fees may increase from 1st January 2021.
